Differences with earlier versions

Previous versions of this work contain errors which were discovered by Naoki Kobayashi. The present version aims at correcting these errors, while clarifying the main changes. We have revised the definition of liveness and safety for types (Definitions 4.4 and 4.5) and removed theorems related to the soundness our analysis of general liveness and safety for types. Finally, we have revised several remarks in the comparison between our work and [2, 1, 4, 3] (Sections 7 and 8).
